

SUBJECTS

We highly recommend you to take between from 240 to 360 class hours per semester.

CREDITS PER SUBJECT

Each subject has normally 60 class hours (contact hours). There is no exact conversion of UnB class hours to ECTS (European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System).

Per semester, a minimum of 180 class hours is common.



Semester long, free of charge for exchange students.


What topics will be covered during orientation?

What is the international office assisting students with?

The international office registers the students at the university, briefs the students on administrative procedures after arrival and assigns UnB students to help international students get used to the university.

Students living on campus housing can go on foot to classes. Others living outside campus will use public transportation, which is free for students who request a student transportation card.
