Information to apply

Documents required to the online form

1. Application Form of Exchange Program - Incoming to students from **Foreign Universities**
2. Cover letter from the University of Origin
3. Transcript Record
4. Resume (máx. 2 pages)
5. Motivation letter, explaining the academic reasons.
6. Passport or identification document copy.

Students who carry out a research stay must present a Work Plan (max. 3 sheets) where the schedule of activities is included.

The documents must be sent by email, in PDF format in a folder with the name of the student until december, 2022. The applications must be sent by the International Relations Offices of the University of origin to the email address of **movilidad.ogcri@unmsm.edu.pe**

Consider that in the period march - july, you can only select odd cycle courses (1,3,5,7,9) and in the September - December period you can only select even cycle courses (2,4,6,8,10). Likewise, the law degree has an annual academic regimen, not a semester.



Academic Information

Academic Load

Students may enroll a maximum of 26 credits (equivalent to 6 to 7 courses). This considers between 15 to 24 hours per week as a full academic load for a semester. Also, you can only enroll in a single faculty.

Transcript of Records

Students from institutions with which UNMSM has signed an agreement and/or cooperation agreements obtain this certificate for free, while students from institutions that do not have an agreement with UNMSM will have to pay for this certificate at the end of the exchange semester.

Academic Costs

During their stay, exchange students from institutions with which UNMSM has signed an agreement and/or cooperation agreements are exempt from paying academic costs and have the same rights as a regular student to make use of the services provided by the UNMSM.

Useful Information

Monthly Living Expenses

The average monthly cost for accommodation, food and transportation in Lima is approximately **US\$250 to US\$350**.

Health and Travel Insurance

Foreign students **must have** health and accident insurance with COVID-19 coverage (this will only be requested once the student is accepted and confirms their stay at UNMSM).

Visa

To carry out your stay in Peru, you do **NOT require a Visa**. It is not necessary to carry out any immigration procedure prior to your arrival in the country; However, you must be very attentive at the hospitalization point, informing the reason for your stay so that they can give you 180 days.
