 Language requirements: IELTS 6.0 (no component lower than 6.0) or TOEFL (internet based) 74 (no component less than 18) or Pearson (PTE Academic) 52 (no component less than 52)

Eligibility

Undergraduate: successful completion of six months of full-time study at a recognised higher education institution + a minimum cumulative GPA of 4.9 out of 7, or minimum average results of approximately 65-70%. Direct from high school applicants will be considered on a case-by-case basis

Postgraduate: successful completion of a bachelor degree or equivalent from a recognised higher education institution

JCU tuition fees are payable only by Study Abroad students; Exchange students continue to pay tuition fees as usual to their home institution.

NB: trimester fees are less than semester fees for equivalent cps as the teaching period is shorter (10 teaching weeks in a trimester compared to 13 teaching weeks in a semester).

Student Services and Amenities Fee (SSAF)

- Currently AUD\$163 for one semester/trimester, AUD\$326 for a full year (amounts subject to change)

Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) jcu.edu.au/international-students/coming-to-australia/overseas-student-health-cover-oshc

OSHC is insurance to assist international students in meeting the costs of medical and hospital care that they may need while in Australia. International students in Australia must hold OSHC for the duration of their stay in Australia, as a condition of their student visa.

Currently approximately AUD\$400 (for one semester/trimester), AUD\$700 (for two semesters/trimesters).
