Academic information	
Full-time study	Students on exchange at NTUS would normally enrol on the equivalent of 12 credits / 6 subjects (216 hours in 18 weeks) per semester.

Attendance requirements	All students, including exchange students, are expected to attend all scheduled classes and activities. Absences should be reported to the lecturers by email.
Modules selection	All nominated students will receive a module selection guide by email along with other application materials.
Transcripts	The Office of International Affairs will dispatch 2 copies of the official transcript (one for the University, one for the student) within approximately 5 weeks of the student's completion of all modules. Incoming transcripts should be emailed to kcchen@ntus.edu.tw

Application procedure	
Academic requirements	<p>A. General Admission Requirements Candidates for student exchange at NTUS must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • normally have completed at least 1 year of full-time university study at the time of entry to NTUS; and • be in good academic standing, holding at least a 2.8 grade point average on a 4.0 scale or an overall C (or 70 points) average or equivalent. <p>B. Language Proficiency Candidates for the student exchange program at NTUS must satisfy the basic <u>Chinese speaking language</u> requirements or be recommended by UW's faculty.</p>
Application process	<p>Students will receive an application form and application instructions via e-mail. They will need to submit the following documents to kcchen@ntus.edu.tw by the appropriate deadline:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A completed and signed application form 2. Resume and autobiography 3. Study plan (about 800 words) 4. Academic transcript (original) 5. 1 to 2 recommendation letters 6. Photocopy of passport (or the photocopy of ID card if no passport is available) 7. Insurance certificate (photocopy) 6-month overseas medical insurance 8. Physical examination form (Form B) 9. Certificate of enrolment (original) 10. Dormitory application form (applicable to applicants of the dormitory) <p>All documents should be submitted as pdfs. Documents should <u>not</u> be posted to the university.</p>
