## **APPLICATION:**

Students contact their coordinator at their home university to inquire if they are eligible to be nominated to the ISAP program.

## **Nominations:**

The coordinator at their home university sends a nomination email to the contact person at Faculty of Hospitality & Tourism(FHT) The nomination should include:

- First and last name of student
- Email address
- Field of study at their home institution 0
- Exchange semester at FHT 0

## **Orientation (compulsory):**

Orientation commences approximately one week prior to the start of the semester.

All incoming exchange and study abroad students are required to attend the Orientation Programme.











All international students **MUST** have health insurance coverage. You will not be permitted to register for courses unless you have health insurance.

Students **MUST** purchase health insurance prior to departure and ensure that the insurance • policy coverage is valid to be used in Thailand.

## Visa:

An acceptance letter will be dispatched approximately 6 weeks prior to the start of the semester.

Visas can only be obtained outside of Thailand from a Royal Thai Embassy or Consulate. The Embassy or Consulate will typically issue a visa sticker in your passport which allows you to enter the Kingdom legally under specific conditions.

- All students who attend Prince of Songkla University, Phuket Campus are required to hold a
  - Non-Immigrant Education Visa or Non-ED Visa. It is illegal to work in Thailand under this visa type.

## **Buddy Program**

All incoming exchange and study abroad students are required to sign up for the buddy program. You will be allocated a local FHT student, who can assist you during your stay in Phuket.

## **Uniform**

All students are required to wear a uniform. The uniform purchase session will take place during the Orientation Programme.

### Motorbike

To rent a motorbike in Thailand, you are required to have a valid motorbike license. It is advisable to obtain this in your own country before departing. Check with your license provider to make sure you are permitted to ride a motorbike in Thailand.

## **Hospitals**

Thailand has some of the best hospitals in the world. On the island of Phuket, there are three world-class international hospitals within 15 minutes from the university.





### **Students from Partner Institutions**

Students enrolled at partner institutions must contact their home university coordinator to confirm eligibility for nomination to the ISAP program.

Once confirmed, the home university coordinator will send a nomination email to the designated contact person at the Faculty of Hospitality and Tourism (FHT).

The nomination email should include the following details:

- -Student's first and last name
- -Student's email address
- -Field of study at the home institution
- -Desired exchange semester at FHT

**Direct Application** Students can apply directly by emailing fht.international@phuket.psu.ac.th. We will assess your eligibility and respond with further details.

### -Summer (March-June):
