





- Funded in 1423
- 29 000 students (12% foreign students)

- From January 1st, 2025: named after Marie and Louis Pasteur, famous French chemists and bacteriologists who discovered the principles of vaccination and pasteurisation.



Language courses

- French as a foreign language (University diploma, intensive courses, French+Sciences summer school...)

University Degree of French Studies (DUEF) - *Mobility Students*

- A semester-long program "Language, culture and society" to:
 - improve your French language skills before studying at a French university or beginning your professional career in France,
 - > or spend a semester or year abroad to develop your knowledge of French language, France and the French-speaking countries.
- One semester: 14 weeks, 234 hours (18 hours/class/week)
- Number of ECTS credits: 30
- Entrance requirement:

A2 level in French







University Degree of French Studies (DUEF) - *Mobility Students*

- Tailored for B1, B2 and C1 levels
- Course content
- Mandatory core modules (listening and speaking, reading and writing, grammar, French culture and society)
- ➤ Wide range of optional classes (literature, art history, phonetics, business French, management, contemporary French history, theatre or French cinema...
- An immersion experience Students participate in immersion projects such as interviews and surveys, visits to local businesses, discovery games and treasure hunts, face to face meetings with writers or cross-cultural workshops with students from local schools









French Language Intensive Course

- 4 weeks sessions, 1 session/month
- 21 hours/week, 5 days/week
- Participants
- ➤ All levels, from the age of 17
- ➤ Specific sessions for beginners : September, November, January, April, June, July, August
- Organization
- ➤ 15 hours of practicing the verbal and written language
- ➤ 6 hours of thematic workshop (phonetics, verbal practice through games, written communication, comic strip workshop, sociocultural workshop, language and theatre, cinema...)
