ACCOMMODATION

As the space is limited, CAFA does not provide on-campus dormitory. We encourage exchange students to find accommodation as early as possible. You should allow approximately 3000 to 5000 RMB per month for Housing.

ADMISSION and VISA

The answer to the exchange application will be given 4-5 weeks after the deadline.

The digital **Admission Letter** and **DQ form** will be sent to the successful applicants via Email which is for them to apply for **X2 VISA** (Short-term Student Visa) to the Embassy/Consulate of China in their countries.

Upon arrival within 24 hours the exchange students must go to the local police station website to register for the *Accommodation Registration Form* with passport and lease contract from the landlord.

INSURANCE

Exchange students must get health care and accident Insurance. Students are responsible for taking out adequate insurance coverage before entering the country.

LIVING IN CHINA

Living in China, you will need local mobile phone number which you can get from the company of China Unicom or China Mobile with your passport.
