Full time study load for one semester

The exchange students can take a maximum of 7 courses per semester, or they can do only the project work without taking any course in a semester. Teaching of the courses shall be reckoned in credits. Credits are assigned to the courses based on the following general pattern:

- Two credits for each lecture period
- Two credits for each tutorial period
- Two credits for each studio period
- One credit per hour for each Laboratory or Practical or Project session

Attendance

If a student has less than 75% of attendance in a particular course, he or she may be disqualified from writing the end semester examination.

SPI Calculation

A Semester Performance Index (SPI) will be computed for each semester in a scale of 10. The SPI will be calculated as follows:

$$SPI = (C_1 * G_1 + C_2 * G_2 + C_3 * G_3 + \dots + C_n * G_n) / (C_1 + C_2 + C_3 + \dots + C_n)$$
 where, n is the number of courses registered during the semester, C_i is the number of credits allotted to a particular course, and G_i is the grade points corresponding to the grade awarded for the course.

Grading System

Based on the performance of a student, each student is awarded a final letter grade in each subject at the end of the semester. The letter grades and the corresponding grade points are as follows:

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Nomination & Required Documents

Partner university selects students according to performance, commitment and nominates them for the exchange semester via email. IITG accepts students within the scope of the exchange agreement. Applications need to be done via e-mail and applications should include the following documents:

1. Application
2. Curriculum vitae
3. Learning Agreement/Study plan (courses students want to attend at IITG).
4. Transcript of records (all grades attained at university), signed and stamped by the students' home institution.
5. Document listing the courses students are attending in their current semester (and therefore are not yet listed in the transcript).
