# Frequently Asked Questions

**Q: What should I wear?**

A: Since Malaysia is a tropical country, light, loose cotton clothing is the best to wear.

**Q: How do I get around campus?**

A: UMS provides shuttle buses to facilitate students and also encourage safety and accidents reduction in university. The schedule for holidays or special events will be updated throughout the year.

**Q: Does the University have accommodation on campus?**

A: Yes, the University has a variety of accommodation.

Note: Given that the students are qualified for financial aid to attend AIMS programme, home universities are responsible for providing living expenses for their students.

A: The host university will be responsible for the pick up arrangement of students from airport.
