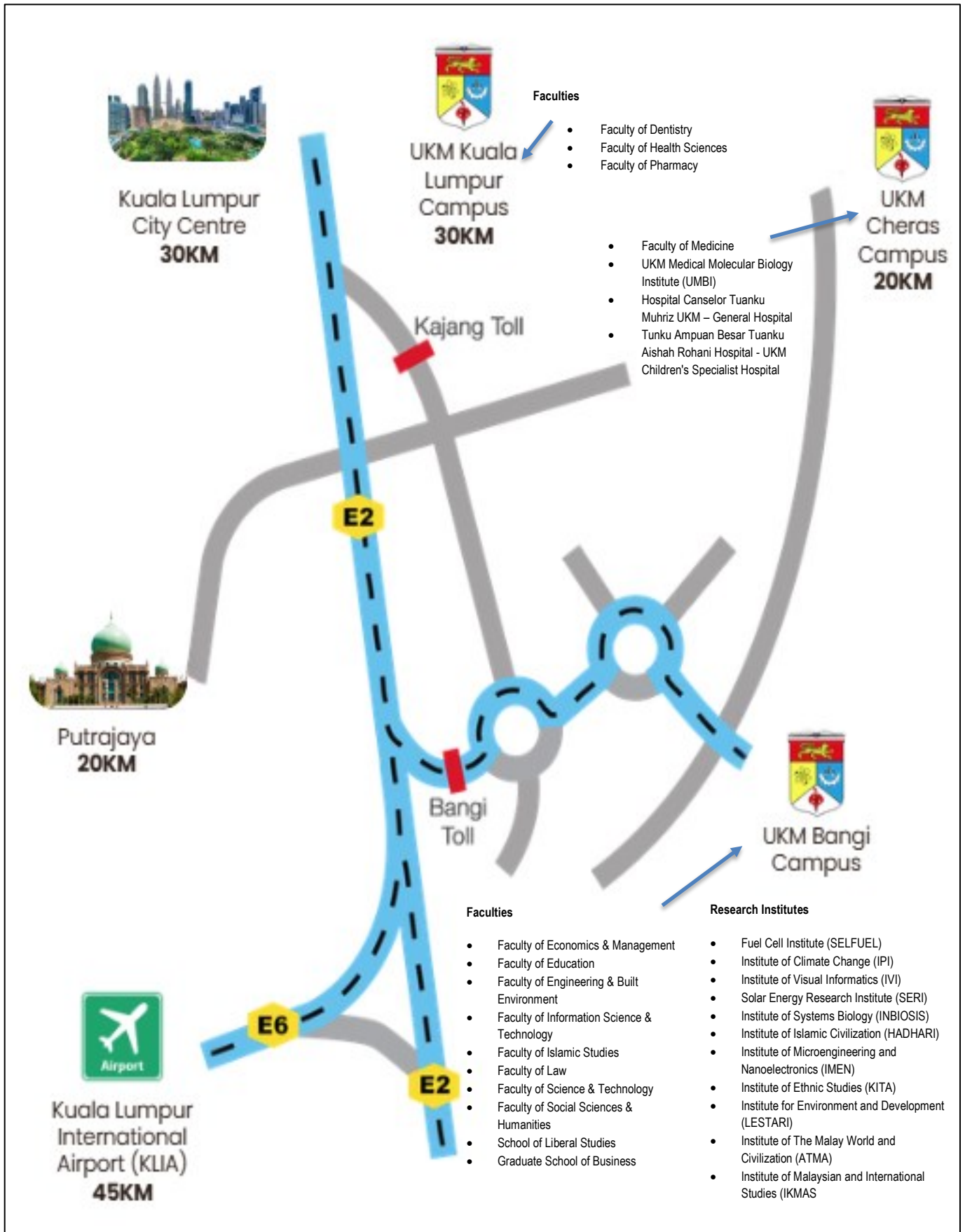

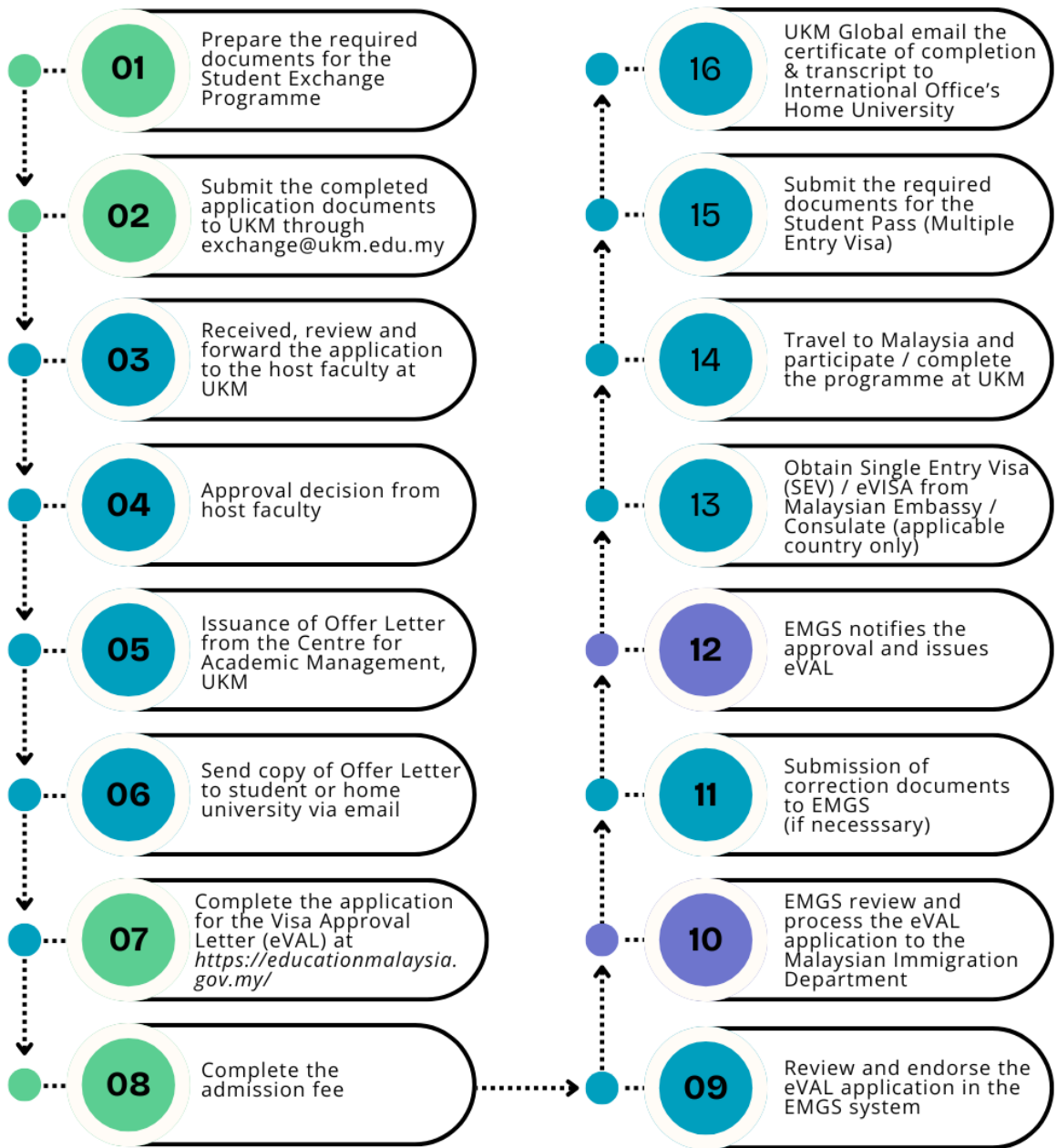

## VISA APPLICATION & HEALTH INSURANCE

<p><b>Visa Approval Letter (e-VAL), Single-Entry Visa (SEV) &amp; Malaysia Digital Arrival Card (MDAC)</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. A Visa Approval Letter (e-VAL) is mandatory for those who wish to pursue their studies in Malaysia.</li> <li>2. e-VAL application is through the EMGS website at <a href="https://educationmalaysia.gov.my/">https://educationmalaysia.gov.my/</a>.</li> <li>3. Single Entry Visa (SEV) or eVISA <a href="https://malaysiavisa.imi.gov.my/evisa/evisa.jsp">https://malaysiavisa.imi.gov.my/evisa/evisa.jsp</a> are require to <u>selected country citizen</u> that need to obtain from the Malaysian Embassy prior to entering Malaysia after receiving the e-VAL.</li> <li>4. <p><b>Health insurance</b></p>	<p>International students are required to obtain insurance coverage while studying in Malaysia. It is compulsory to purchase insurance from the EMGS system while applying for a Visa Approval Letter (e-VAL).</p>

## ACCOMMODATION

<b>Accommodation</b>	<p>UKM Global will assist in making the accommodation arrangement at the <b>Ibu Zain Residential College (KIZ)</b> only. It's located on the UKM Bangi campus (main campus) and accommodation is subject to availability. Students can choose either the following type of room:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Single room: <b>MYR 730 monthly</b>.</li><li>• Twin sharing room: <b>MYR 540 monthly</b>.</li></ul> <p>(Students are required to pay a 1+1 rental deposit upon enrolment at the residential college).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Residential access card: <b>MYR 5</b>.</li><li>• College activity fee: <b>MYR 50</b> (compulsory for the student who stays on campus).</li></ul> <p>Fill up the <a href="#">Application form</a> and submit it to UKM Global at <a href="mailto:exchange@ukm.edu.my">exchange@ukm.edu.my</a>.</p> <p>Please note that students assigned to the Kuala Lumpur and Cheras campuses are required to make their own accommodation arrangements.</p>

## ARRIVAL & AIRPORT PICK-UP SERVICE

<b>Arrival in UKM</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Students are advised to enter Malaysia via <b>KLIA or KLIA2 terminals</b> and are permitted to arrive up to seven (7) days prior to the registration date.</li><li>2. UKM will provide airport pick-up services to KIZ on selected dates. All students are required to submit their arrival details via the Google Form provided.</li><li>3. Students will be required to undergo a health medical check-up at the UKM Health Centre (Bangi campus) within seven (7) days of arrival in Malaysia.</li><li>4. Students are required to apply for a Student Pass for Mobility (Multiple Entry Visa – MEV) at least seven (7) working days before the expiry date of the Special Pass (as stamped in the passport).</li></ol>

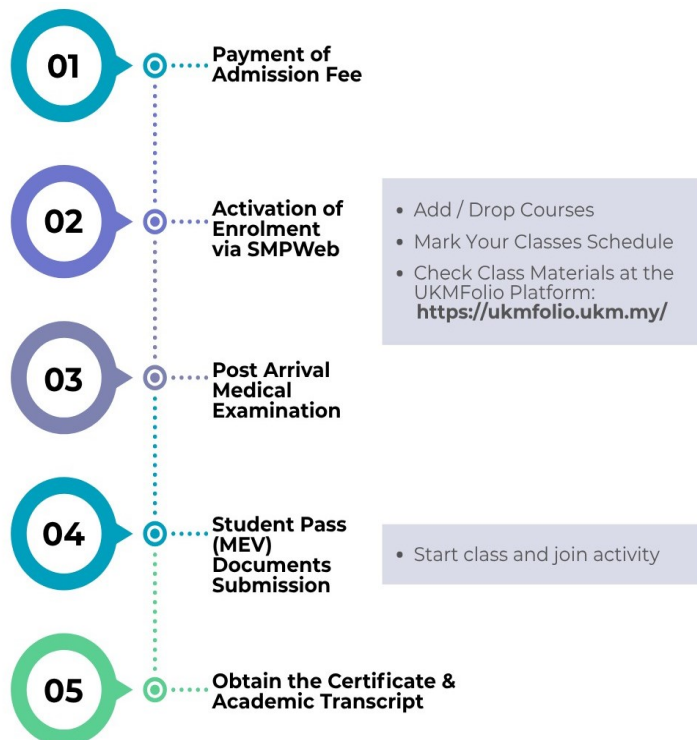

<b>Result and Official Transcript</b>	<p>All students may view and print the Examination Results via SMPWeb <a href="http://smplucee.ukm.my/smpweb">http://smplucee.ukm.my/smpweb</a> or <a href="https://www.ukm.my/smpweb">https://www.ukm.my/smpweb</a>.</p> <p>An official academic transcript issued by UKM Academic Management Centre will be sent to the International Office of the student's home university approximately six (6) weeks after the announcement of examination results.</p> <p>Please be informed that UKM will issue and send the official transcript via email only. Should the home university require a hard copy, the postage cost shall be borne by the respective institution.</p>

## APPEAL FOR RE-EVALUATION

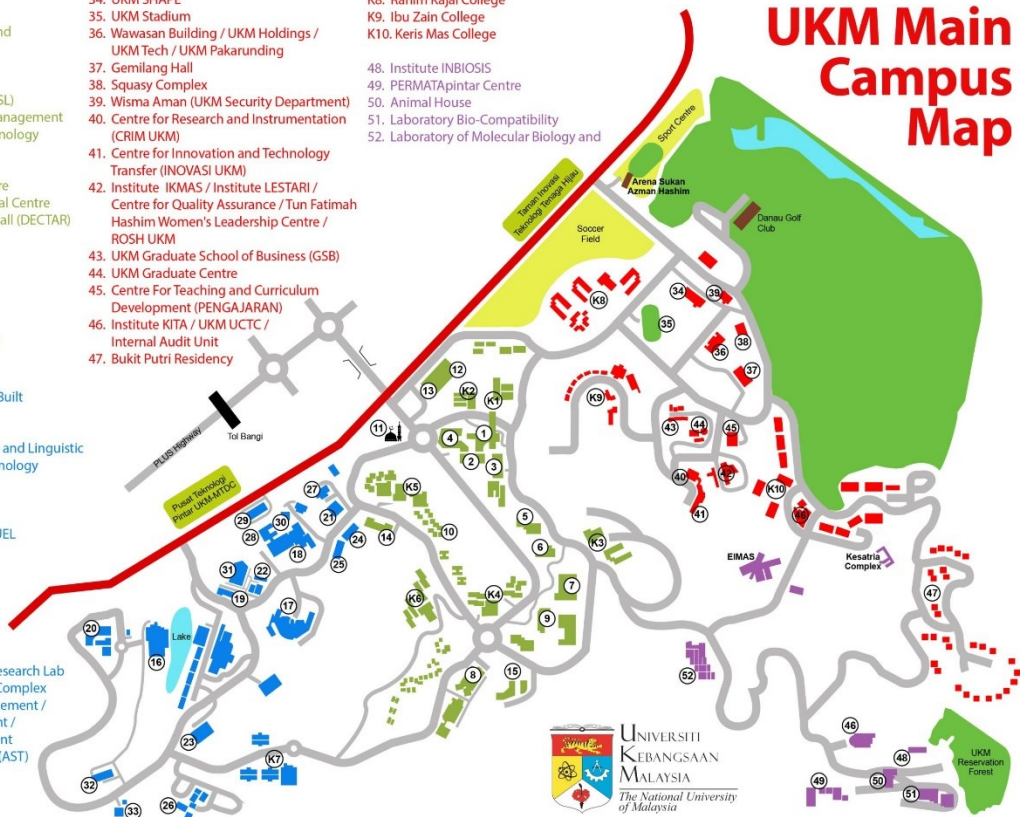
<b>Appeal for Re-Evaluation of Final Course Examination Results</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. An appeal for the re-evaluation of a course assessment result must be submitted in writing by the student to the faculty within four (4) weeks after the official examination results are announced. Appeals submitted after the specified period will not be considered.</li><li>2. A processing fee of approximately RM50 will be charged for each course appealed.</li><li>3. All decisions made by the faculty under this regulation, once approved by the Senate, are final, and no further appeals will be considered.</li></ol>
